



# WORK NOTICE

Former Gas Holder  
Redwood City, California  
July 2011



Field work scheduled for weekends of July 23<sup>rd</sup>, July 30<sup>th</sup>, and August 6<sup>th</sup>

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is sending this work notice to inform you that Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) will be performing field work as part of an environmental investigation at 675 Jefferson Avenue in Redwood City, California. A bank currently operates on a portion of the property and the remainder of the area is paved and used for parking. From 1914 to 1959, a gas holder was located on the site. PG&E contractors, under the oversight of DTSC, will be conducting sampling work to help develop a plan to clean up impacts from historic gas-storage activities. To minimize disruptions to area businesses, work will be conducted on weekends only, the work area will be marked with traffic cones, and field workers will take measures to minimize disruptions.

Work will take place between the hours of 1:00 pm and 10:00 pm on Saturday July 23, 30, and August 6, 2011 and between 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 24, 31, and August 7, 2011. Field work will be conducted after the bank’s operating hours to avoid inconveniencing customers and area businesses. The following will take place during this field work:

Activity	What you can expect to see
Approximately 25 borings will be drilled within the parking lot area of the bank.	A drilling rig will be brought on-site to drill into the ground. Samples of soil will be collected and analyzed for residues from the gas storage activities. A round of soil vapor (the air around soil) samples will also be collected.

All work will be conducted in accordance with a site Health and Safety Plan. An environmental project manager will be on-site to monitor field activities. All utility lines in the area have been identified and precautions will be taken by on-site workers so that utility lines are not disturbed during field activities.
