## **EnviroStor Data Management System: DTSC Enhances the Public's Access to Inspection and Enforcement Data**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) announces the launch of enhancements to its EnviroStor Data Management System public web site. The site now provides detailed information on inspections and enforcement actions of permitted hazardous waste facilities.

EnviroStor continues to provide all existing information on permits and corrective action at hazardous waste facilities, as well as site cleanup projects. EnviroStor will now allow searches for information on completed facility inspection and enforcement actions, in addition to site investigation, site cleanup, permitting, and planned, current or completed corrective actions under DTSC's oversight.

At this time, only information from inspection activities and enforcement actions completed on or after 2009 will be available. The data from the years prior to 2009 will be made available when the accuracy and quality is confirmed.

**Note:** Sensitive and/or confidential information on inspections and enforcement actions will not be made available.

**Public Access to EnviroStor** is available via the DTSC Web Page located at: <http://www.envirostor.dtsc.ca.gov> EnviroStor allows you to perform various interactive functions, including:

- "Basic" or "Advanced" searches allow the public to obtain more refined results. Search results are displayed in tables and can be exported.
- "Reports" section, which allows users to search by program type: Senate, Assembly, and Congressional Districts; land use restrictions; permitted facilities; commercial offsite hazardous waste facilities; public notices issued in the last 60 days; sites/facilities with draft for public review in the last six months; and completed inspection activities and enforcement actions at permitted facilities, and other specific topics.
- Location information provided through a Geographic Information System (GIS) application with enhanced mapping features.
- Uploaded documents can be viewed and downloaded, providing ease of access to information.

- “Information” section with links to other DTSC Web Pages and guidance documentation for EnviroStor users.
- Subscribe to Email Alerts provides users a notification when new documents are available on a project.
